**CITY COUNCIL MEETING**  
**January 28, 2019**

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The Greenville City Council convened in the Council Chamber at City Hall on Monday, January 28, 2019, at 5:30 p.m. for a regular meeting. Mayor Dexter McLendon called the meeting to order. City Clerk-Treasurer Dee H. Blackmon was absent so April Lawrence called the roll and recorded the following members present: Mayor McLendon, Councilmembers Bryan Reynolds, Ed Sims, Tommy Ryan, Jimmy Lawson and Boris Thigpen. Mayor McLendon led those attending in the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag. Councilmember Ryan delivered the invocation.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Mayor McLendon advised each councilmember had received for review a copy of the proposed minutes for the Regular Council Meeting held on January 14, 2019. He asked if there were any additions, deletions or amendments to the minutes as presented.
